#### Glass / Paper and Cardboard / Plastic / Metal

Bottles, tubs and trays / Food tins, drink cans, foil / Aerosols / Tetrapaks / Pringles lids and paper tubes.

Where: Brown bin at home



#### Garden plant material and food waste

→ Where: Green-lidded bin at home



#### Soft Plastics

Crisps, popcorn, nuts & pretzel packets; confectionery wrappers; fruit, vegetable and salad bags; multipack film wrap; baby, pet food and microwaveable food pouches; coffee bean and ground coffee pouches; carrier bags; clothing bags; bubble wrap; dishwasher tablet packaging; toilet roll and kitchen roll wrapping

# **No**: compostable or biodegradable bags

Where: Soft plastic bin at Morrisons or Waitrose





Beauty, health and wellness product packaging (including toothbrushes, interdental brushes, flossing sticks and toothpaste tubes)

→ Where: Boots, Spring Gardens

## Biscuits

Sweet and savoury biscuits, crackers, cake, cereal bars, rice cakes, Twiglets, mini cheddars, Ryvita types.

**No**: confectionery wrappers – these go in soft plastics bins

→ Where: Transition Buxton hard to recycle bins

All brands of flexible packaging for coffee bags, loose leaf tea packs and bulk bags of tea bags.

**No:** coffee bean and ground coffee pouches – these go in soft plastics bins

## **Bread Packaging**

All brands of plastic bread bags, Warburtons wax wrap.

No: combined paper and film window bags

Note: need to register first, see <u>here</u>.</li> </ul>
